



GENERAL GUIDELINES ON QUALIFICATIONS, REGISTRATION AND MECHANICS

The mechanics specified in this document apply to all events of The Fermin Cup 2018. Each event has its own set of rules and regulations provided in each particular section.

We recommend all coaches and/or advisers to carefully read and fully understand these guidelines and in each event's section. We likewise advise that the same set of rules is fully discussed to the participating students.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. The Fermin Cup 2018 is open to all students of primary and secondary educational institutions recognized by the Department of Education (DepEd) within and around the City of Santa Rosa.
2. All participants must be bona fide students of their respective schools for the school year 2018 - 2019.
3. The School Head is requested to certify the qualification of all participants.

REGISTRATION

4. Registration forms are provided in this invitation kit. They can also be downloaded from the HRC website (www.hrcsrl.edu.ph).
5. Completely-accomplished forms must be submitted **on or before September 17, 2018 (Monday)**.

7. Incomplete data in the registration form is a ground for disqualification.

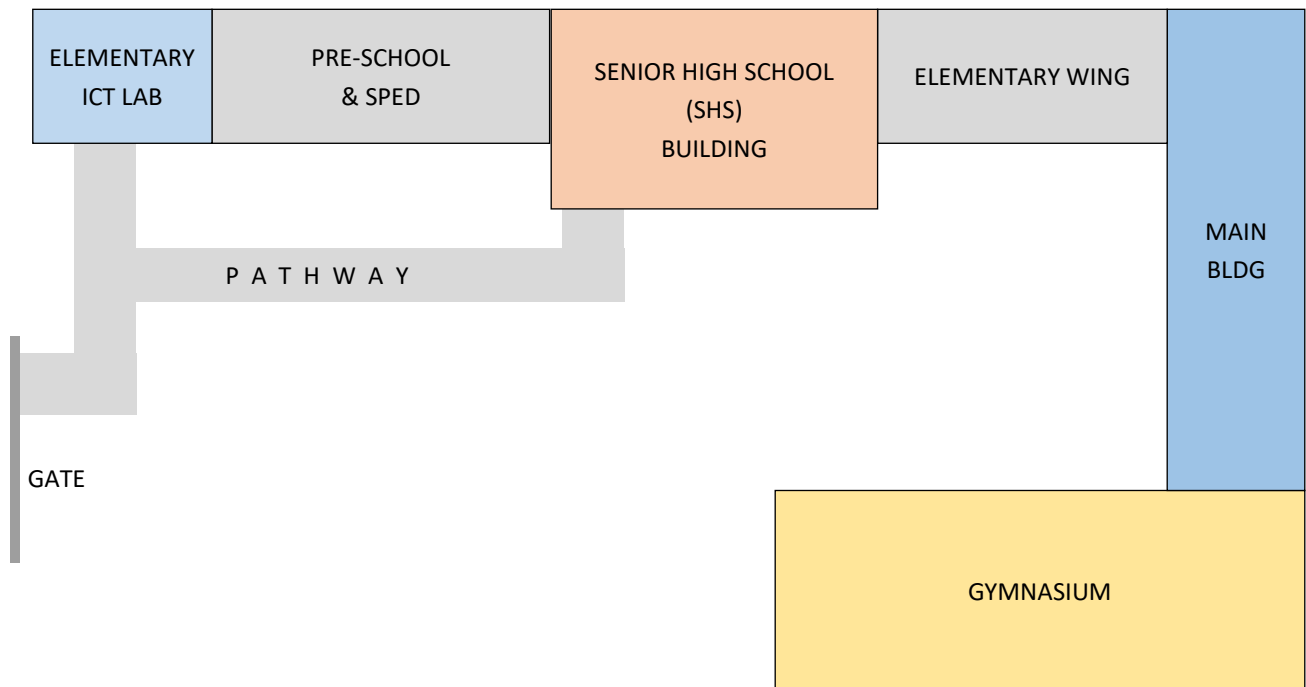

MECHANICS

- Participants and their coaches/advisers are requested to be in the venue by **7:30 AM** for proper registration and briefing. Opening ceremonies will commence afterwards.
- Each participant must bring his/her **school ID**.
- For all academic contests:
 - There will be an Elimination Round if the number of registered participants exceed ten (10).
 - The **Elimination Round is a sit-down individual exam**.
 - Three (3) additional questions will be given in the Elimination Round. They will be considered in case there is a tie on the 10th place. Participants are strongly advised to answer these questions.

- D. Incomplete and/or misspelled answers will be considered wrong answer.
 - E. All questions will be read twice, after which the timer starts.
 - F. Late answer will be considered no answer.
 - G. In the event that only one team answered a question correctly, the score for that question will be doubled.
 - H. Coaching from the audience is strictly prohibited and may lead to nullification of questions and/or disqualification of participants.
 - I. Complaints and clarifications will be entertained by a panel of judges immediately after the answer is shown or before the next question is revealed.
 - J. The decision of the panel of judges is final.

OVERALL SCORING AND RANKING

- 14. Overall ranking will be determined by the amount of medals each participating school wins.
- 15. The school with the most number of Gold medals will be declared the Overall Champion. Silver and Bronze medals will be considered if there is a tie of Gold medals won.

AWARDS AND PRIZES

- 16. Event winners will receive medals and gift prizes.
- 17. The Overall Champion will receive The Fermin Cup 2018 Trophy and **PHP 10,000.00** cash prize.
- 18. The Overall First-runner up will receive a trophy and **PHP 6,000.00** cash prize.
- 19. The Overall Second-runner up will receive a trophy and **PHP 4,000.00** cash prize.
