QUALIFICATIONS AND REGISTRATION

1. Participating schools may send only one (1) team for this event.
2. The team should be composed of three (3) students from Grade 7 to 10 with at least two (2) Grade 10.
3. Each member of the team must not be a participant in other events.
4. Pre-registration is required. The Registration Form must be submitted on or before September 17, 2018 (Monday). Refer to the General Guidelines on how to submit the Registration Form.
5. Participants must present their school IDs upon registration on the day of contest.

SPECIFICATIONS AND FORMAT

6. The size of the poster must be set to Letter (8.5 x 11 inches) in Portrait orientation, with a resolution of 150 dpi, and RGB color mode.
7. Any violation to the specifications and format of the poster will have a 1.0 deduction from the final score.
8. Each team will use one (1) computer.
9. Each team must finish the poster in two (2) hours using Adobe Photoshop.
10. Ten (10) raster images will be provided which can be manipulated and used in the poster. Creation of other elements must be by the students. Failure to comply will result to automatic disqualification.
11. Only default brushes and patterns are allowed.
12. The poster will be based on a theme which will be announced on the day of the event.

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

13. The posters will be judged according to the criteria below:

Appearance	40%
Uniqueness	20%
Creativity	20%
Relevance to the Theme	20%
TOTAL	100%

14. The decision of the panel of judges is final.

AWARDS AND PRIZES

15. The top three (3) teams will get medals.
